

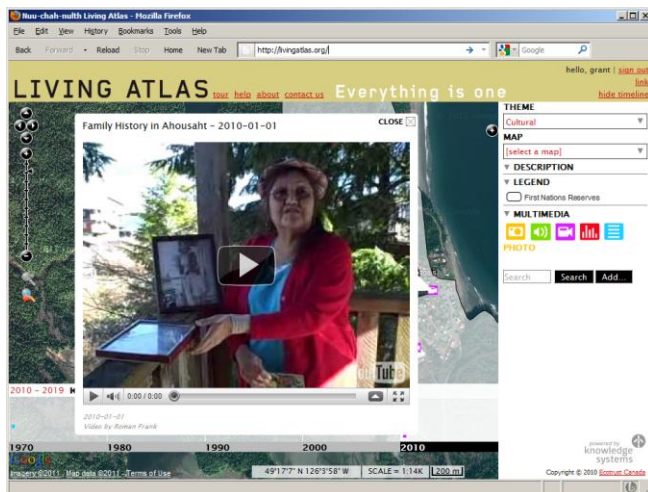
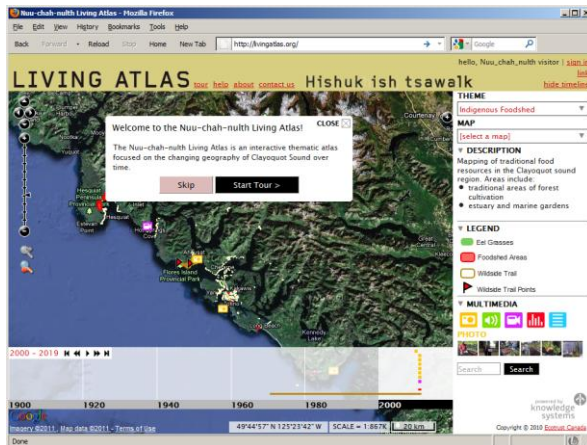
# LIVING ATLAS

- Postgres/PostGIS relational database
- OpenLayers, MapServer
- jQuery
- All components built with open source software
